

BROADSHEET MEDIA X TOURISM NEW ZEALAND COMPETITION TERMS & CONDITIONS

PROMOTION DETAILS

- By participating in the Broadsheet Media x Tourism New Zealand Summer Competition (Promotion), each
 participant fully and unconditionally agrees and acknowledges that these terms and conditions are binding.
- The promoter is Broadsheet, trading as Broadsheet Media Pty Ltd, ABN 20 131 593 201 of Level 1, 231 Smith Street, Fitzroy, VIC 3065 (Promoter).
- 3. The Promotion commences at 12:00 (AEDT) on Monday 6 February 2023 and closes at 23:59 (AEDT) on Wednesday 22 March 2023 (Promotion Period).
- 4. Entry is open to Australian residents only who are over 18 years of age.
- The terms and conditions were updated on Tuesday February 28, 2023 due to the unavoidable impacts of Cyclone Gabrielle in New Zealand.

HOW TO ENTER

- 6. To enter this Promotion, you must go to https://broadsheet2.typeform.com/to/SdkTdgUY and enter your details including first name, last name, postcode and email address, and answer to the promotional question in 25 words or less, "Tell us why New Zealand is your ideal holiday destination?" You must agree to sign up to receive news and marketing, including special deals and offers from Tourism New Zealand.
- 7. This is a game of skill and chance plays no part. The Promoter's decision is final, and no correspondence will be entered into with entrants.
- 8. Multiple entries are not permitted.
- Entrants can only enter in their own name. The use of automatic entry software, mechanical or electronic
 devices that allows an individual to automatically enter the competition is prohibited and may render all
 entries submitted by that individual invalid.
- Employees of the Promoter, immediate family members of any employee, and any associated company or agency of the Promotion are not eligible to enter.
- 11. Entries not completed in accordance with these terms and conditions are void. Entries will be deemed void if stolen, forged, mutilated or tampered with in any way.
- 12. Entries are received at the time of receipt by the Promoter and not the time of transmission by the entrant.
- 13. The Promoter reserves the right to alter the rules of the competition at any time.

ENTRY CONTENT

- 14. Entrants are required to take full responsibility for the content of their entry and for ensuring that their entry complies with these Conditions of Entry. For the purposes of these content requirements, "entry content" includes any content (including text, drawings, designs, images, files, photos, videos and email messages) that entrants submit, upload, transmit, publish, communicate or use in connection with their entry into the Promotion.
- 15. Incomplete and ineligible entries will be deemed invalid. Entries will also be deemed invalid if they breach these Conditions of Entry as determined by the Promoter in its sole discretion or any other content guidelines notified by the Promoter during the entry process for the Promotion.
- 16. Entries must be the entrant's original work. The Promoter reserves the right to verify, or to require the entrant to verify, that the entry is the entrant's original work. If an entry cannot be verified to the Promoter's satisfaction, the entry will be deemed invalid.

If an entrant has any doubts about whether they have the right to include any content (for example, recorded music) they must not include it. By including any such content in their entry, the entrant warrants that they have the permission of the relevant copyright owner to do so and that this permission allows the Promoter to use the entry in accordance with these Conditions of Entry.
- 20. The Promoter may, in its absolute discretion, edit, modify, delete, remove or take-down any part of an entrant's entry if deemed offensive or otherwise non-compliant with these Conditions of Entry.

By submitting an entry to the Promotion, each entrant grants the Promoter a perpetual, irrevocable, non-exclusive, royalty-free, worldwide, transferrable and sub-licensable licence and right to use, reproduce, edit, modify, publish, and communicate to the public all information, material, and intellectual property (including, without limitation, any works or other subject matter in which copyright subsists, and any images, designs, trade marks, patents, or trade secrets, and any associated rights) contained in or constituting that entry in connection with the Promotion. By submitting an entry, each entrant consents to any dealings the Promoter or its sublicensees may have with the entry content under the foregoing licence that may otherwise infringe their moral rights (including rights of attribution and integrity or against false attribution).



PRIZES

 - One night's accommodation for two people at QT Hotel Auckland on Monday 4 March, 2024 (valued at \$425 AUD).
- 23. Total prize pool value is at approximately \$8,969.50 AUD (including GST.) The total prize pool is determined by an international exchange rate as of Tuesday 17 January 2023.
- 24. The winner will be required to agree to the current Booking Conditions at the time of booking including any applicable policies or waivers that are in place at the time.

- 29. Entries will be judged by a judging panel comprising representatives of the Promoter. Entries will be judged on originality.
- 30. Judging of all entries received during the Promotion Period will take place at Level 1, 231 Smith St, Fitzroy, Victoria 3065 at 11:00 (AEDT) on Thursday 23 March 2023. The judges will judge all complete, eligible entries received during the Promotion Period in accordance with the judging criteria. The best complete entry, as determined by the judges, will be declared the provisional winner. The Promoter will draw five (5) reserve entries and record them (in order drawn) in case an invalid entry or ineligible entrant is drawn as a winner or the winner is unable or unwilling to accept the prize.

- 32. In this email the winner will be sent instructions to redeem their prize.
